

Dear Member,

The current IFAF committee recognises the deep division in our federation.

We put forward the following proposals for your consideration:-

(1) That IFAF be split into two separate units under the sponsorship of a three person Directors' Committee who will be non voting trustees .

These trustees will be the holders of IFAA affiliation.

(2) The two separate units will be designated as IFAF Domestic and IFAF International.

(a member's club will determine initial affiliation to either IFAF Domestic or IFAF International)

Members may be represented on each of the independent committees according to initial membership for one year .

A fee of € 5 may be paid to the alternative group, giving dual membership. This fee to be paid to the group being joined.

No dual membership holder may sit on the committee of the second group so joined during that membership year.

Dual membership will allow for both domestic and International participation.

For a year-long cooling off period , clubs may refuse membership at their discretion.

For an initial period of one year, independents must join a club, at a fee to be agreed on a case by case basis.
